



## *Campbell River Coed Adult Volleyball League 2018-2019*

Welcome to another exciting year of volleyball! There are some changes for this season so please carefully read the information below. Note that these may be updated at anytime, notice will be provided.

### Rules and Regulations

Each team will have a 10 minute warm-up (7:30-7:40 for the first match, and so on) before their scheduled 50 minutes of playing time. Matches will be the best two of three. **Games are rally point to 25, cap at 27. If a third game is necessary, play will be to 15 or until the end of scheduled playing time, whichever occurs first.** Each team must have a minimum of 5 players on the court, 4 players is a forfeit but may continue to play. Each team must have a minimum of 2 females on the court but may play with 1 female and 5 players total. A team that can not field the league minimum within 10 minutes of start time defaults the 1st game 25-0 and if after 20 minutes can not meet the minimums defaults the 2nd game 25-0.

4 Original players (from team roster) must be on the court to count for a win. Teams are permitted to pick up a maximum of 2 players per match; only 1 of the 2 players may be from a higher tier division. **No pickups are permitted during the playoffs.** All players must be registered to a team 5 weeks prior to the end of the regular season and must have a signed waiver. A legitimate player must have played a minimum of 5 nights to be eligible to play in the playoffs.

Any protest during a game should be brought to the referee and noted on the appropriate score sheet. The team captain registering the protest should also notify the league administration within 24 hours. Failure to do so may result in the protest being denied.

For insurance purposes, all players who play in the league must have a signed consent form. **Captains are responsible** to ensure that all players on their team, even those occasional players, are listed on their team lists and have signed a consent form. The forms will be held by the league administration.

Teams will be ranked in order of games won, sets won and points +/- . Ties are to be broken by win/loss record between the tied teams. Play-offs will be a two game knock out tournament over the last three nights of the season. All regular league rules will apply in the play-offs.

Unless otherwise stated referees and players will follow, to the best of their abilities, all rules of play outlined under the Volleyball Canada guidelines. Players and referees will at all times behave in a respectful manner and demonstrate sportsmanship in accordance with the good spirit of the game. The aim of the league is first and foremost to promote a fun, inclusive environment and an appreciation of the game of volleyball.

***All players are reminded that the referees are working without umpires and lines persons. It is a privilege to have referees for our league. Please treat them with the respect they deserve. Only a team captain may dispute or make enquiry about a call to the court referee.***
